

Privacy policy

We appreciate your interest in our firm and our products. We are firmly committed to maintain your privacy when visiting our site. Some of the information kept on SABCA's web server is information that you volunteer to provide through forms while other information is collected automatically. Unless you volunteer to submit personal data yourself, SABCA will not collect any information from which individual visitors can be identified.

Information automatically collected and stored

SABCA's web server automatically collects non-personally-identifiable information. Typical thus collected information includes the domain name of your Internet access provider, the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect the visitor's computer to the Internet, the visitor's browser type and version, operating system and platform, the average time spent on our site, pages viewed, information searched for, access times and other relevant statistics. SABCA uses this information in the aggregate to measure the use of its site in order to improve its use and quality of information provided.

SABCA's web site also deposits "cookies" in a visitor's computer. A cookie does not collect an individual visitor's identifying information. The purpose of this technology and the information it provides is again to help us to improve SABCA's web site. Most web browsers allow the user to deny or accept the cookie feature. However, please note that cookies may be necessary to provide you with certain features (e.g. customized delivery of information) available on SABCA's site.

Personal information you voluntary provide

In order to receive personalized services, you will be asked to provide personal information (e.g. name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address). No material consequences will result from your refusal to submit such information except that you may not obtain the functionality or receive information you requested.

By submitting your personal data to us, you will be treated as having given your permission for the processing of your personal data as set out in this policy;

SABCA will use personal information only for the purpose indicated to you when you provided it.

SABCA will not disclose, sell, rent or exchange such personally identifiable information to any other organization or entity unless the user is first notified and expressly agrees to it, or as otherwise required by law.

Please note that, in accordance with the Belgian Act of December 8, 1992, you are entitled to request SABCA to provide you with additional information. You are also entitled to have access to your personal data and to have these data rectified in the event they would appear to be incomplete or inaccurate. Finally, you are entitled to object at any time and free of charge to the further processing of your personal data by sending us a request by regular mail or email with a copy of your ID card to the address mentioned below.
